## 5. SELECTION SYSTEM

### 5.1. ALL EVENTS

5.1.1. 2 Qualification Scores from 3 Selections:

- Monthly Shoot in May and July
- Singapore Shooting Championships or Monthly Shoot in June
- All participants in the 3 selections who qualify to finals must participate in the final or their qualification score will be void.

5.1.2. Only Singapore Citizens are eligible to be selected.

### 5.2. IN THE EVENT OF A TIE

In the event of a tie, a shoot-off will be organised.

## 6. THINGS TO NOTE

6.1. The name list to be submitted to the SNOG will be decided by the SSA Council with the advice from the HP Department.

6.2. The final team list will need to be approved by the Singapore National Olympic Council (SNOG). **Please note SNOG's selection mark is a minimum of the 3<sup>rd</sup> placing score of the last SEA Games or equivalent.**

6.3. SSA may include additional selection competitions with prior notice, depending on changes in the competition calendar locally or internationally.

6.4. Changes prior to final entry deadline can still be made due to:

- i. Sickness or Injury
- ii. Lack of Training Discipline
